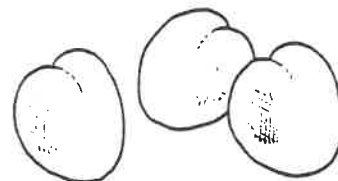


When the singular form ends with s-sh-ch-x, add es.

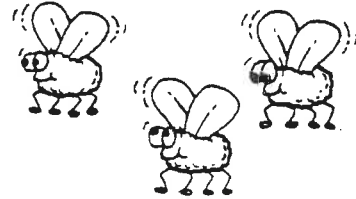


When a singular noun ends in a **consonant** and **y**, change the **y** to **i** and add **es**.
