If You Choose to Break the Rules

Levels of consequences:

- 1st Verbal warning
- 2nd Clipboard marked Rehearse rules before going out to recess.
- 3rd "Time-Out!" worksheet filled out at recess & sent home for parent signature or contact made by phone.

 Some behavior problems can result in immediate loss of recess and time-out. Such behaviors include not completing homework, leaving binder at home, rude or hurtful comments directed at other students/adults, and roughhousing in the classroom.
- 4th Office Referral: Severe problems such as habitual classroom disruption, cheating, fighting, harassment, or insubordination will result in an immediate office referral, possible removal from class, and/or a meeting between parents, teacher, student, and principal.
