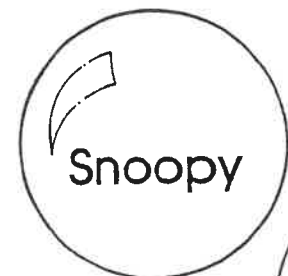
A proper noun names a particular person, place or thing.
