- at the end of a question. Did you mail my letter?

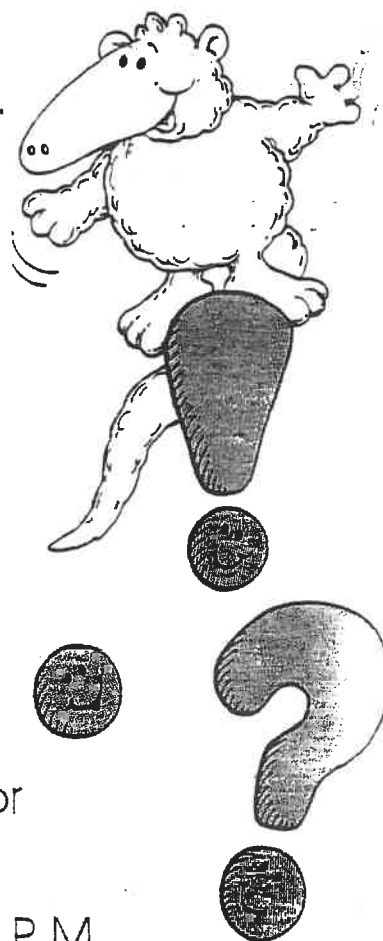
An exclamation point is used...

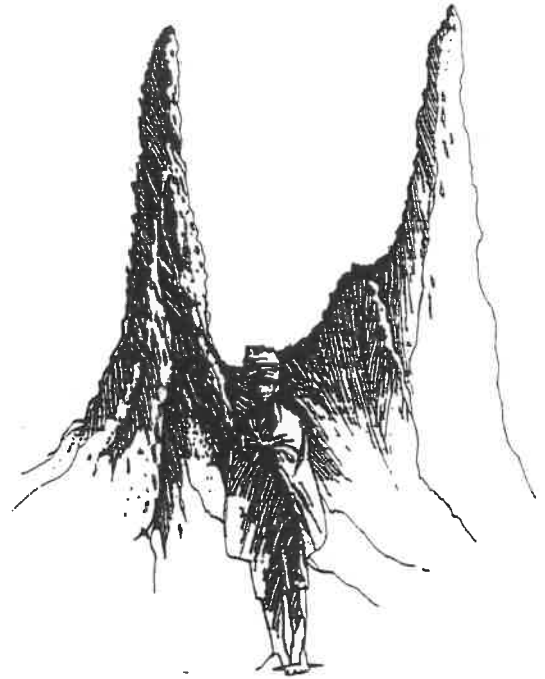
