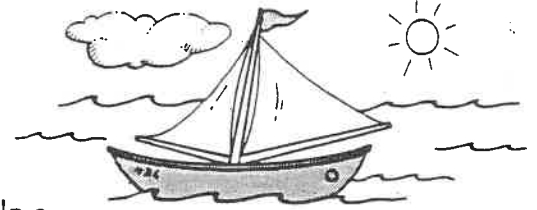


Verbs

Verbs are words that show action or say that something is.

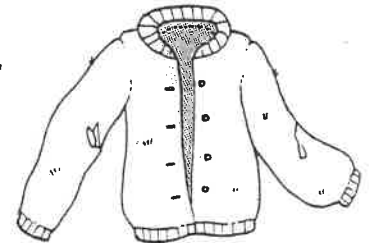
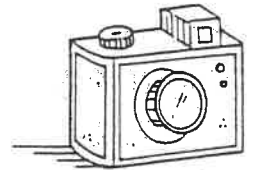
We sailed on Lake Michigan.

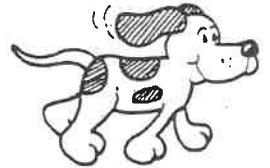
Action Verbs

Dogs run.

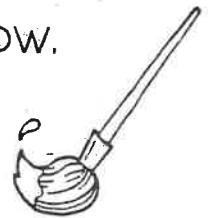
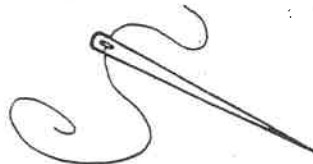


Some action verbs tell about actions you can see. Others tell about actions you cannot see.
